



Biltmore Forest Country Club



Founded in 1922, Biltmore Forest boasts a Donald Ross golf course maintained at the highest standard, elegant Clubhouse facility and appointments, fitness center, tennis facilities, pool and offers a wide variety of member activities. Our historic Clubhouse and Donald Ross designed golf course are situated on 135 acres in the Town of Biltmore Forest, North Carolina. The Town of Biltmore Forest is a planned residential community with a rich cultural history.

The 18 hole golf course is 6,770 yards and consists of A1 Bentgrass greens, Zeon Zoysia fairways, approaches, bunker faces, tees and Turf Type Tall Fescue Rough. Biltmore Forest Country Club is currently ranked #19 in North Carolina and has been recognized by Club Leader's Forum as a Platinum Club of America, a distinction awarded to the top 3% of private clubs. The course has hosted numerous prestigious championships including the 1999 U.S. Women's Amateur and the 2013 U.S. Women's Mid-Amateur.

The Club has undergone many changes and renovations over the years with the most recent being a new \$2.95 million golf maintenance facility. Other recent renovations include a \$6.4 million restoration of the golf course and a \$1.8 million restoration of the Clubhouse in 2015. Both projects had as their mission to restore the Club's facilities back to its original 1922 splendor. Plans for a renovated fitness, pool, and tennis facility are being prepared for presentation to the Membership for potential construction in 2021-2022.
