Description

The Kitchen Garden internship involves hands on work with all aspects of the sustainable production, maintenance, and display of our perennial fruit, vegetable, and herb crops. Interns will assist with annual planting design and installation, soil building and compost management, chemical free weed and pest management, harvesting produce, distributing food to campus food pantry, social media content creation, leading volunteer groups and giving tours.

- Ability to lift up to 40 lbs., and work outdoors in heat, humidity, rain, cold and dust.
