Preface

Weed Management in Commercial Nurseries and Professional Landscapes

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Our intent is to assist commercial plant producers (field and container) and professional landscape maintenance personnel with weed management strategies in the production and/or maintenance of commonly produced nursery crops in Tennessee. This publication provides information on herbicide options, application timing, suggestions to improve success, sprayer set-up, calibration steps, a summary of the commonly used pre & postemergence herbicides, including ornamental plant tolerance, control of weeds, conditions for optimum herbicidal performance, rain-fast times, re-entry intervals, and management of an Enviromist (a hooded applicator for glyphosate).

The tables offered here are a summary of the herbicide labels currently labeled for use on the specific plants listed. This compilation provides the user a quick reference to compare and facilitate herbicide decisions. The label may provide more detail. This effort is not intended to replace the actual herbicide product label(s). Before using any pesticide, read, understand and follow the actual herbicide product label directions. Herbicides included here were registered for the prescribed uses when this information was gathered. However, herbicide labels are constantly being reviewed and revised. Cancellation of the registration of a herbicide or the prescribed use will constitute a withdrawal of the herbicide recommendations.
