- Coordinate and execute tarp pulls
- Prepare field for batting practice
- Ensure field is lined and ready for each game
- Set up additional events such as concerts and corporate events
- Responsible for vehicle and equipment maintenance (gators, mowers, rollers, painters, graders)
- Manage the irrigation system including proper water management of the playing surface
- Maintain ballpark standards and cleanliness
- Assist with day-to-day operations in the ballpark
