


Inside a Championship Rebuild

In Fall 2025, Ridgewood is beginning a multi-year, phased rebuild of our putting greens to full USGA specifications, complete with SubAir units.

As a 2026 intern, you won't just watch from the sidelines. You'll work on both original pushup greens and new USGA-spec surfaces, giving you a rare chance to compare construction, moisture behavior, firmness response, and turf performance across two different systems, all with the same Poa annua surface.


Whether prepping turf, analyzing moisture maps, or walking construction timelines with our leadership team, this is learning that goes deeper than a textbook.
