



2026 Summer Turfgrass Internships

November 1, 2025

The Quechee Club in Quechee Vermont is a private second home community situated on 5,000 acres, featuring a 36-hole championship golf facility currently ranked among the top ten in the state of Vermont. In addition to the two fine golf courses, there are 11 clay tennis courts, two Platform tennis courts, indoor and outdoor pools, health club, Ski Area (both Downhill and Cross Country), 50 Acre man-made lake with beach, kayaking, and fishing available. There is also a rich array of other outdoor activities located throughout the “Upper Valley” area of Central Vermont.

The Quechee Club has 2 summer intern positions available for applicants who are highly motivated, golf career-oriented, team players, willing to work hard to learn all aspects of the golf course management profession. The club offers a unique and enriching experience for interns that are tailored to an individual’s experience & needs. Interns who have worked here in the past have had excellent work experiences with many going on to become leaders in the Golf Course Maintenance Industry. Quechee interns become part of the management team and experience; daily monitoring for diseases and insects, course set-up, fertilizer and pesticide applications (interns are required to get a Vermont pesticide applicators license), involvement in construction and landscape projects, irrigation maintenance and repair, equipment maintenance and repair, tree plantings & pruning, along with some light supervisory responsibilities.

Compensation packages include: \$21.00/hr starting wage, (\$1.00 increase upon acquisition of a Vermont Pesticide Applicators license), free on-property housing, uniforms, use of the club facilities, half price food at club food outlets, overtime available, and a unique learning experience. Positions start as early as March 2026 and can go into October or later if available.

The maintenance programs at Quechee are on par with other top New England private clubs. The greens were completely rebuilt on both courses after the 2011 flooding from Tropical storm Irene, utilizing the California sand method and were sodded with A1/A4 Bentgrass. The rebuilt greens have matured nicely and the maintenance programs are focused on keeping them pure bentgrass for as long as possible utilizing all the latest chemistry and cultural programs timed and designed to encourage bentgrass. In addition, in 2022, the club completed the installation of a new High density plastic irrigation system on both golf courses, with the installation having been done by Tanto Irrigation. The new system is a Rainbird I/C double & triple row system, which replaced the existing 50+ yr old PVC, Rainbird decoder system.
